

RESULTS OF SCJA QUESTIONNAIRE JANUARY 1986
(Based on 453 replies)

THE LARGEST RESPONSE FOR EACH QUESTION IS INDICATED, GIVING THE PERCENTAGE, WITH THE APPROPRIATE, YES OR NO. *EXCEPTION IS NUMBER 10, WHICH INDICATES APPROXIMATELY 12% OF OUR MEMBERS ARE AKC DELEGATES. (The exact figure will be ascertained at a later date).

1. 66% YES Have the new procedures for additional breeds negatively affected your future plans for requesting additional breeds or groups?
2. 86% YES Do think the new procedures for additional breeds or groups will result in fewer multiple breed judges?
3. 82% YES If a shortage of multiple breed judges does materialize, do you think it will adversely affect the cost of putting on a show?
4. 86% NO Are you convinced of the competence of the AKC Field Representatives to evaluate your judging as well as your procedure?
5. 81% NO As a judge, do you think the new procedures will actually educate the judge thereby improving the quality of judging?
6. 91% NO Do you think the new procedures will make you a better judge?
7. 69% NO As a judge, are you satisfied with the present breed standards, which are the tools with which you work?
8. 98% YES Since negative letters and reports received by the AKC are reviewed at the time a judge applies for additional breeds, should you have the right to see copies of these letters or reports and be offered the opportunity for rebuttal?
9. 71% YES Are you a member, Officer or committee Chairman of an AKC member show giving club?
10. 12% YES* Are you a delegate to the AKC?
11. 64% YES Does the delegate receive, from the club specific instructions on how to vote on key issues?
12. 96% YES Are you willing to work through your club, to change the system to benefit the clubs and judges?
13. 99.8% YES Are you in favor of these surveys to afford your board a quick response as to membership opinions on current or proposed actions affecting our members?
